I understand that parents are required to remain at the rink to supervise skaters under the age of 13.

Christmas Brook FSC requires **ALL** skating families to volunteer 5 hours for club fundraising events during the season during Baystate Games weekend and/or Show weekend. ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of the opportunity to participate in U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned events and activities during the 2023-24 U.S. Figure Skating Competition Season ("Events and Activities"), the undersigned, individually, and on behalf of his/her heirs, personal representatives, administrators, agents, successors and assigns (collectively referred to herein as "Participant"), AGREES TO ASSUME THE RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY, TO RELEASE AND TO INDEMNIFY U.S. Figure Skating, Christmas Brook FSC its directors, officers, coaches, members, employees, officials, committees, volunteers, clubs, affiliates, sponsors, representatives, agents, successors and assigns, including the host club, local organizing committee and any other entity responsible for the hosting and/or conduct of the Events and Activities (collectively referred to herein as "U.S. Figure Skating"), as follows:

1. Assumption of Risk and Responsibility. Participant fully understands and appreciates the risks of injury that may occur in ice skating or in the course of preparing for, participating in and traveling to or from the Events and Activities. The risks of injury that may occur include, but are not limited to, the risk of, serious bodily injury, viral infections, bacterial infections and risk of other communicable diseases and illness, permanent disability, paralysis and death (collectively referred to herein as "Risks"). Participant acknowledges that Participant voluntarily engages in such Events and Activities with adequate knowledge of such Risks; and agrees that Participant fully assumes all such Risks and all legal and financial responsibility for (a) any and all injuries or damages, whether to person or property, that Participant may in any manner sustain in connection therewith or in the conduct and management of the Events and Activities, including such injury or damage that may result from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause and (b) all treatment, hospitalization and other care rendered to Participant in the event of Participant's illness, injury or other emergency circumstance in connection with participation in the Events and Activities, subject to any applicable insurance coverage.

2. Release and Indemnification. Participant hereby fully and forever releases, discharges, holds harmless, and agrees to indemnify U.S. Figure Skating from and against any and all liabilities, claims, demands, lawsuits, damages, and judgments, present or future, known or unknown, valid or invalid, direct or consequential, together with reasonable costs and attorneys' fees, which result directly or indirectly from damages, losses, injuries or death to Participant, Participant's property, other persons or property incurred during or in connection with any activities associated with or being a part of the Events and Activities and the conduct and management thereof, including any participation, travel or medical treatment, hospitalization or other care rendered in connection with the Events and Activities, whether such loss, damage, injury or death results from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause.

I have read this Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release, and Indemnification Agreement, fully understand its terms, UNDERSTAND THAT I AND THE MINOR HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature. I INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THAT THE REMAINING PROVISIONS SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

ICE RULES FOR FREESTYLE SESSIONS

1. Skater must check in with a Board Member or Rink Monitor or sign in at the beginning of skating session prior to entering the ice so attendance can be taken. Skaters must also pay for their ice time PRIOR to entering the ice if buying on. Do not enter the ice unless you have paid or are scheduled to skate.
2. Pinny vest must be worn at ALL times by the skater practicing their program or dance over the rink speaker.
3. All skaters need to be aware of their surroundings and do their best to avoid others. Any skater wearing a pinny vest has "right of way," meaning all other skaters will make every effort to move out of the way.
4. Music is played in order of request, with skaters in a lesson taking precedence and bumping others. NO Exceptions. Three times repeat maximum.
5. Parents are asked to assist with playing music during freestyle ice. There is no signup, but we would request that you make time and offer to play the music. ADULTS only playing the music.
6. Parents and family members are not allowed in the hockey box during skate times as this is distracting to skaters and is a safety issue. NO Exceptions.
7. Coaches may videotape their students during lessons. Parents may videotape their child, and ONLY their child, while the child is wearing the pinny vest.
8. For safety reasons, there is no reckless skating allowed, i.e. no tag, racing, horseplay, etc. There is no group socializing allowed on the ice.
9. After a fall, skaters should get up as quickly as possible in order to avoid injury to other skaters.
10. **No use of headphones or earbuds on the ice for safety reasons.**
11. CBFSC coaches, board members and/or rink monitors have the authority to

enforce ice rules to maintain the safety of all skaters.
